- Accountability





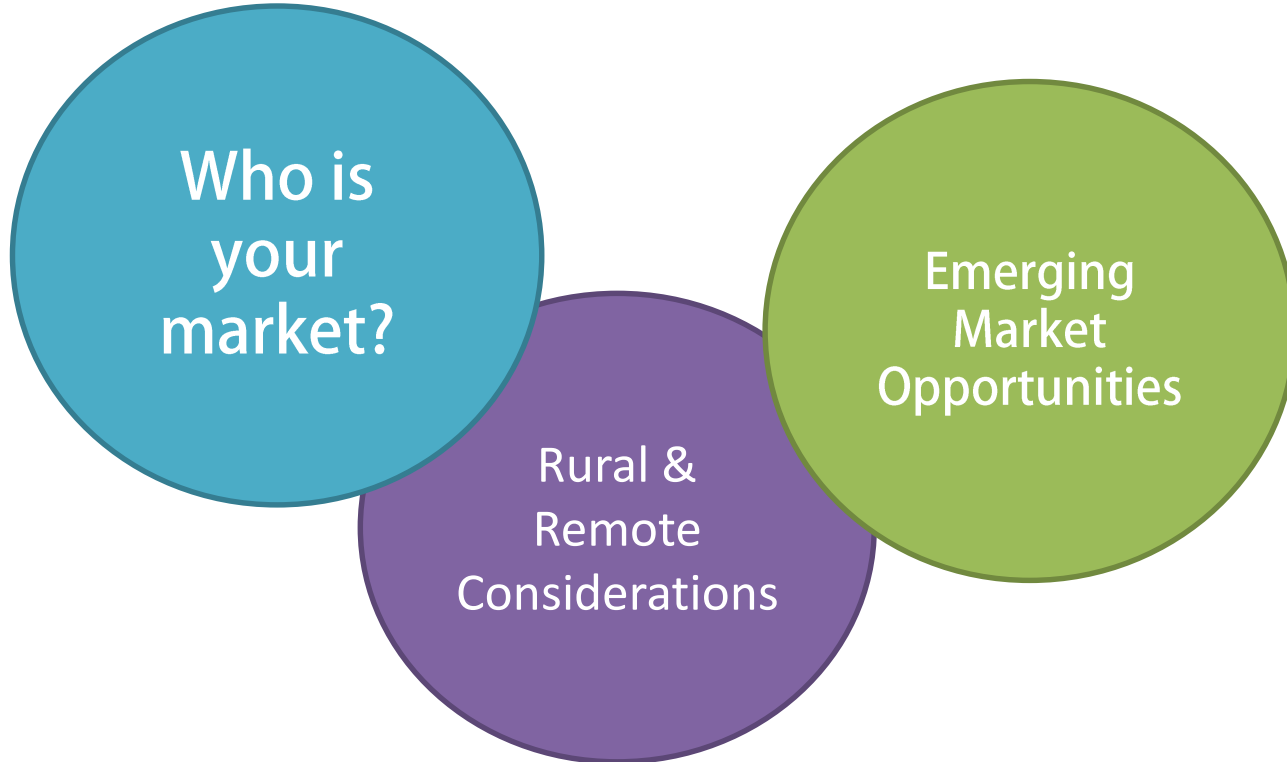
